1 Roll Call & Welcoming Remarks from REIC National Staff

Maura McLaren welcomed all participants and introduced the staff. All participants did a roll call.

2 What's New at National

Maura notified everyone that the new Manager of Marketing and Communications, Pam Seran-Wallace, has started. Dues invoices are going out in mid-November. The 2013 Annual Conference is being held in Winnipeg, MB and will hopefully be in Quebec for 2014. She also mentioned the successful IREM conference that was held in San Diego.

3 New Payment Option

Soumidh Mondal explained that REIC has been working with banks to have REIC has a payment option from people's bank accounts. It is currently offered with all the larger banks except HSBC.

9 Mentorship Programme

Walter explained that the Toronto Chapter had created a Mentor Programme that National has adopted. The program is currently only in Toronto but available to all chapters. The document is available online to all chapters.
