

Using a Social Media Login to Access REIC Member Only Areas



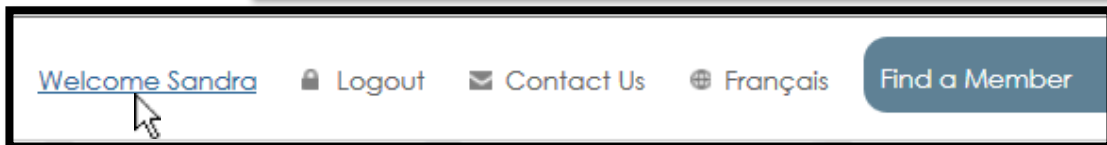
Switch Your Login in from an Email to Social Media

Logging in to www.reic.ca just became a lot easier!

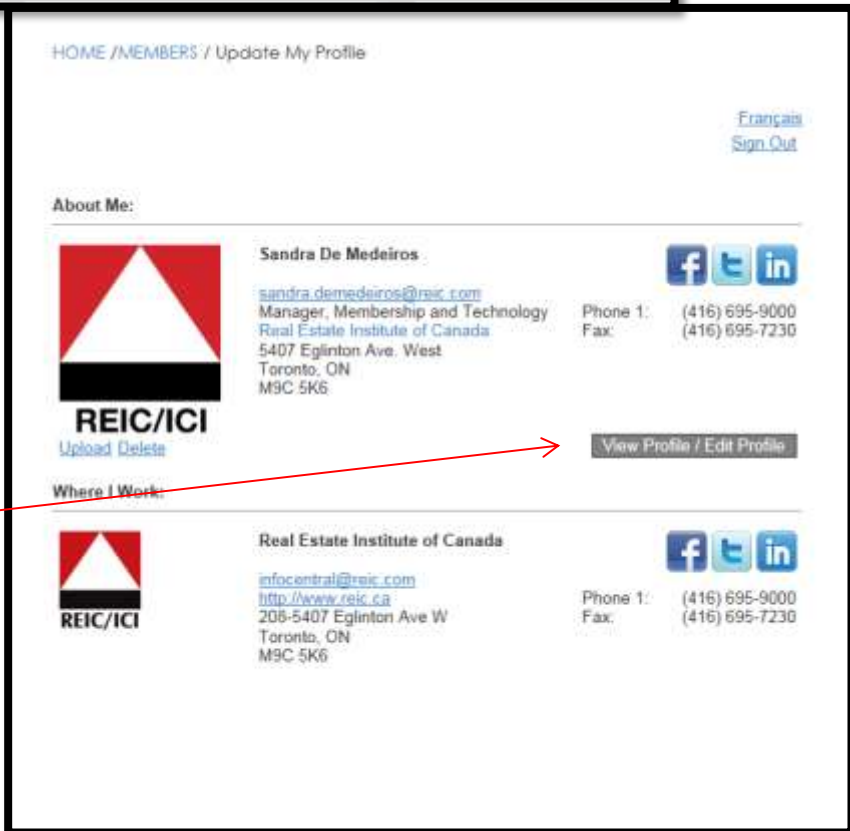
If you have a <<socialmediatype>> you can use this to access the many features available to you on the site!



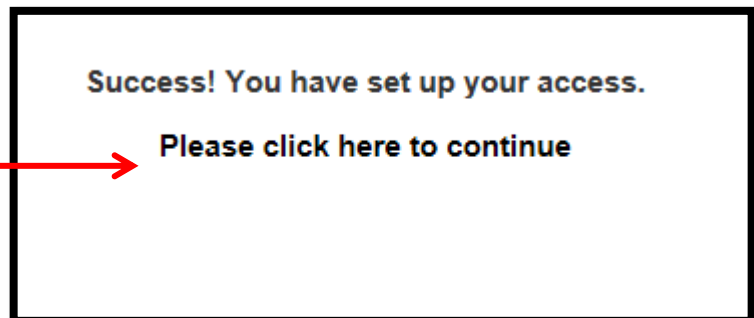
Setting up LinkedIn

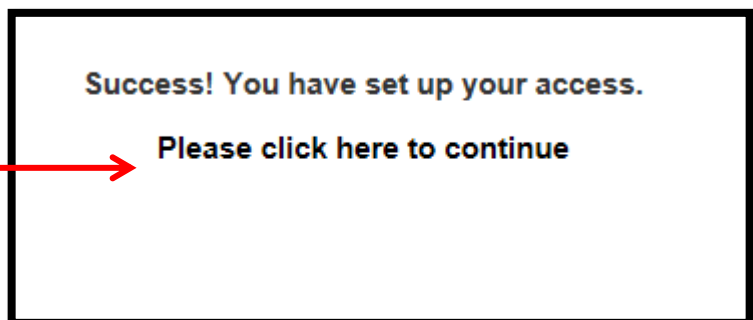


Setting up Twitter

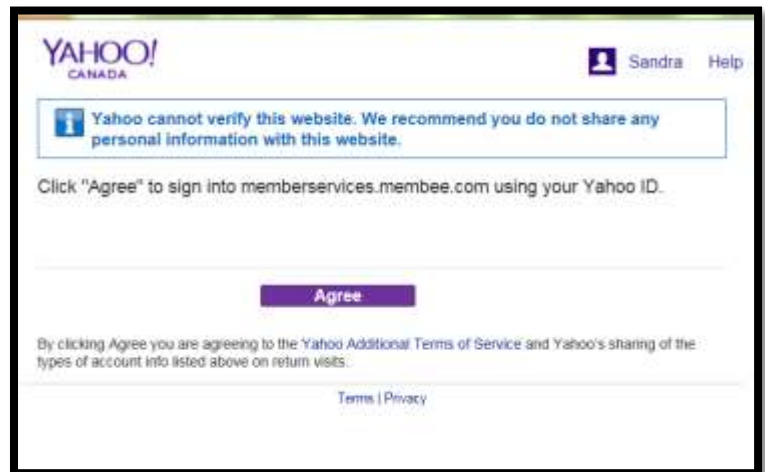
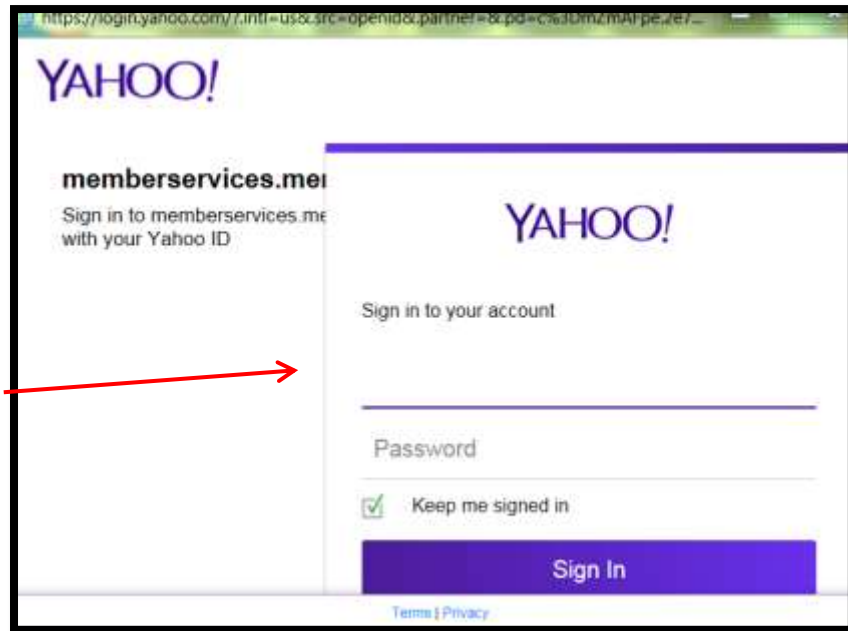

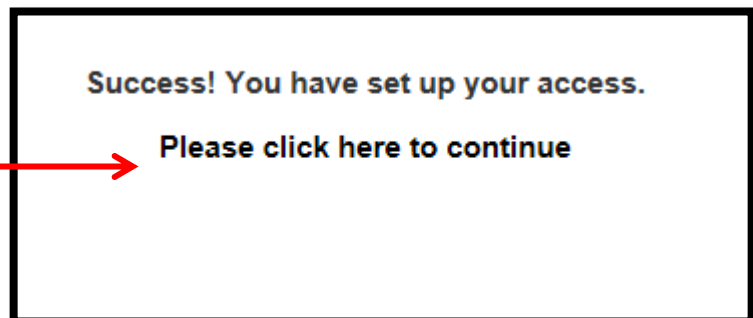


Setting up Yahoo

- Click to continue



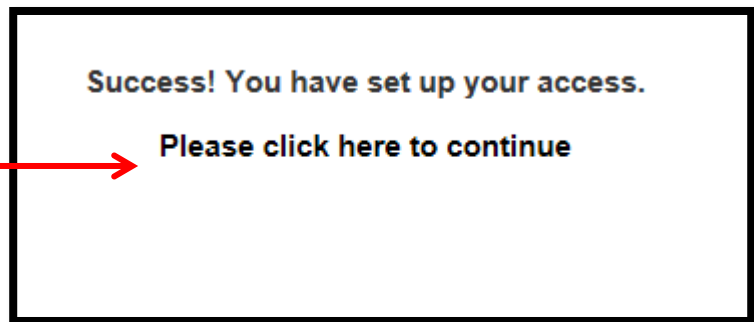


Setting up Facebook
